THE ASSESSMENT EXERCISE

The assessment exercise will be conducted on Tuesday the **30th of July, 2024** and the shortlisted candidates must report to the Chikowi Building, at the University of Malawi by **6:00 am on the same day**.

All candidates must bring the following:

- a) **Original certificates or formal notification of their MSCE (6 credits, including English) or its equivalent;**
- b) **Original or certified copies of their Diploma or Degree certificate (as applicable);**
- c) **Identification document (National Identification Card or Drivers' License or Passport); and**
- d) **Letter from employers confirming the number of years worked in a department or organization that engages in legal work, human rights activism, administrative law, commercial law, criminal law or any other branch of law (Where applicable).**

Candidates will be required to undergo a verification exercise and candidates whose documentation does not confirm the information on the application form will not be allowed to sit for the assessment exercise.

The names of the successful candidates will be released in time for the start of the new academic year in **September 2024**. Shortlisted Candidates are expected to meet their own transportation and accommodation arrangements.
